LifeChanger of the Year is an annual national recognition program honoring K–12 educators and school employees across the country.

The nomination process is simple. All you need is some basic information about your LifeChanger and a short statement on how the nominee is changing lives.

Anyone, including administrators and parents, can nominate up to three educators per academic year for LifeChanger of the Year. Students are also welcome to submit nominations (with the support of an adult if under the age of 18).

To qualify, nominees must be a K–12 educator, teacher, administrator, or any member of a school's staff who makes a positive difference in the lives of students. The LifeChanger of the Year Awards will be granted without regard to race, gender, religion, age, national origin, sexual orientation or disability.

The LifeChanger of the Year selection committee, comprised of past LifeChanger of the Year winners and higher education professionals, reviews the nominations and selects multiple winners for each school year after nominations close.

To be considered for a LifeChanger of the Year award, nominees must:

- Make a positive impact in the lives of students
- Enhance their school or district's atmosphere, culture and pride
- Demonstrate exemplary leadership at the school and/or district level
- Possess a proven record of professional excellence
- Show commitment to building a nurturing environment that supports learning
- Adhere to the highest moral and ethical standards
